II. Important notes

- 1) **Bold courses are required** to be completed prior to going to the Fairfax campus. Failure to complete required courses can result in the delay of requisite permission to study at the Fairfax campus.
- 2) *Italicized courses are recommended* to be completed prior to going to the Fairfax campus.
- 3) Accounting students must take two four-credit lab Natural Science courses.
- 4) 120 credits are required for graduation, with at least 45 of those credits coming from upper-level courses (i.e., 300 and/or 400-level courses).
- 5) Students interested in declaring a double major and/or minor must first speak with an academic advisor from the respective department/s.
